
# PREPARATION BEFORE FUMIGATION

## Please follow these instructions

In order to keep our prices low, your cooperation is essential in preparing your property for fumigation.



#### SAMPLE ITEMS THAT MUST BE DOUBLE-BAGGED OR REMOVED:



Pretzels and other food packaged in plastic bags.



Pet food and animal feed in bags and boxes.



Any food, feed in jars or cans where the original manufacturer's airtight seal has been broken.



Anything in metallic foil lined containers, such as pouches, boxes or blister packs.



Medicine, tobacco, vitamins, ingestible pills, cosmetics, and toiletries.



Anything in re-sealable containers including plastic containers, like Tupperware.



Eggs, fruits, vegetables and any other forms of produce.



Ice cubes should be discarded and the ice maker turned off.

### ITEMS THAT CAN REMAIN UNBAGGED:



Wine and alcoholic beverages with manufacturer's airtight seal intact can remain unbagged.



Canned products like soup may remain unbagged,airtight metal provides an airtight seal.



Un-opened plastic bottles with manufacturer's airtight seal intact can remain unbagged.

## **DOUBLE-BAGGING INSTRUCTIONS:**



1. While bags are still empty, place one inside another.



2. Place items inside 3. Twist the top of the inner bag. DO NOT overfill-leave clearance on top for closure of the bags.



the inner bag, fold once and secure the fold in place using tape or a twist tie.



4. Repeat step 3 with the outer bag.



5. Check the seal by pressing gently against the sides of the bag and listen for air leaks.

IMPORTANT: Keep these and other such bags out of children's reach.

## THE FUMIGANT IS A RAPIDLY DISSIPATING GAS WHICH REQUIRES NO SURFACE CLEANUP.

I will do the required preparation:
